Summary

DSIA's Boolean IA maturity assessment quantifies the state of an information architecture using four basic values against the primary interests of IA practice. This chart produces a maturity index for new and existing domains.

The maturity index value does not measure performance, it provides insight into the state of readiness of an underlying information architecture. The greater the functionality and amount of information within a domain, the higher the overall maturity index value should be.
